## **SCHOLARSHIPS FOR SEPTEMBER, OCTOBER & NOVEMBER**

### **1) GenM Scholarship - \$5,000 - 4 Awards (Deadline: September 30, 2019)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Currently be in high school, college, or university.
- B) Be at least 16 years of age on the day of the deadline.

### **2) Money Metals Exchange Scholarship Program - \$2,000 - 5 Awards (Deadline: September 30, 2019)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior, undergraduate student, or graduate student.
- B) Have an interest in economics. Note that you do not have to plan on majoring in economics.

### **3) Capstone Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: September 30, 2019)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be at least 13 years old and enrolled or will enroll in a college or university in the US.
- B) Be a legal resident of the U.S. or Puerto Rico.

**4) Odenza Marketing Group Scholarship - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: September 30, 2019)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be between the ages of 16 and 25 on September 30th, 2019.
- B) Have a GPA of 2.5 or greater.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be currently enrolled in a U.S.-based high school or college.
- B) Be at least 13 years of age or older.

**6) Create Real Impact Scholarship - \$1,500 - 13 Awards (Deadline: October 5, 2019)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be between the ages of 14 and 22.
- B) Be a legal resident of the United States.

**7) Hispanic Heritage Youth Awards - \$3,500 - 180 Awards (Deadline: October 15, 2019)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be currently enrolled in high school and graduating in the spring of 2020.
- B) Have a minimum unweighted 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale or 7.5 on a 10.0 scale.

**8) Women's Ministries Scholarship Program - \$20,000 – 49 Awards (Deadline: October 15, 2019)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a woman who is committed to serving the mission of the Seventh-day Adventist Church who would otherwise be unable to afford a college education.

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Show academic excellence.

B) Demonstrate dedication to community service.

**11) Horatio Alger Scholarship - \$25,000 – 106 Award (Deadline: October 25, 2019)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be enrolled full time as a high school senior in the United States; be progressing normally toward graduation in spring/summer of 2020 with plans to enter a college in the United States.

B) Exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a bachelor's degree at an accredited non-profit public or private institution in the United States.

**12) You Deserve It Scholarship - \$1,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: October 29, 2019)**

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a resident of any of the 50 United States, District of Columbia or US Territories.
- B) Be 16 years of age or older and be enrolled in college or registered in a high school.
